Meet Time: 10:00 am

TAKE-OUT LOCATION: West Glacier River Access

Approximate Take-out Time: 5:00 pm

Is there a cost associated with this trip? No

Do I need to arrange my own shuttle? Yes, and we can arrange our own shuttle as a group at the put-in. It's approximately a 30 min drive round trip to set shuttle.

The whitewater stretch of the Middle Fork of the Flathead is approximately 8 miles of Class II-III rapids. It's characterized by bright blue water, colorful rocks, and pool/drop style rapids! It's a popular stretch of river and is close to nearby towns. From Columbia Falls, it's approximately 40 minutes to the put-in. While there's no camping available at the put-in or take-out, there is plenty of camping available nearby at both developed and dispersed sites along Hungry Horse Reservoir and along the lower North Fork of the Flathead. This is a great chance to connect with a chapter officer and other RMS members in the area!
