Timing and milestones for York River PWSR Study

Dec 2014. Bill passage by Congress authorizing the York River Wild & Scenic Study

Mar-Dec 2015. Outreach and engagement with partners and communities to solicit candidates for the York River Study Committee and inform public of study status; Study Committee formation

Oct 2015-Jan 2020. York River Study Committee meetings convened monthly

Dec 2015. Initial funds awarded through a 5-year Cooperative Agreement to conduct the study

Feb 2016. Study coordinator hired

April-June 2016. Developed and populated new website; organized subcommittees; developed initial outreach materials and convened initial public forums about the study

Mid-2016 to mid-2018. Intensive study, information gathering, and documentation; commissioned and managed three new studies of river resources (fish study, historic resources study, and build-out study/ordinance review); over 60 public meetings convened, 12 workshops held, dozens of presentations and attendance at public events; sustained communications with active website, media releases, flyers, and email updates

Oct-Nov 2017. Study Committee's unanimous decision to recommend pursuing designation for York River and major tributaries; identified specific river segments and classification

Oct 2017-July 2018. Developed the *York River Watershed Stewardship Plan*; Study Committee approval of plan

July-Aug 2018. Town-held public hearings on warrant articles for November ballot

Nov-Dec 2018. Community votes to approve Stewardship Plan and pursue designation

Feb 2019. York River designation bill introduced in House (116th Congressional session)

2019-2020. Continued outreach by York River Study Committee and engagement of communities, local groups, state agencies, and legislators

Jan 2020. NPS releases its York River Wild and Scenic River Study Report for public review and comment

Dec 2020. York River designation bill introduced in Senate (116th session)

Mar 2021. York River designation bills <u>reintroduced</u> in House and Senate (117th session); Subcommittee hearings held in June 2021 (Senate) and November 2021 (House)

July 2021. Department of Interior transmits NPS York River WSR Study Report to Congress
