

Boundary Waters

Application Process: There is a lottery for Fall Lake entry points D (Fall Lake & Beyond) and 24 (Fall Lake) and Moose Lake entry points F (Moose-Newfound-Sucker), G (Moose-Prairie-Basswood) and 25 (Moose Lake) during the Quota Season May 1 - September 30.

New for 2019: Permit reservations will be released on a first come, first served basis beginning at 9:00 a.m. Central Time on January 30, 2019 at www.recreation.gov or by calling (877) 444-6777, rather than by a lottery system.

Fees: New for 2019: A \$6.00 non-refundable reservation fee is required for *every* quota permit, including 'walk-in' permits and Day Use Motor permits.

Use Fees: A per person user fee is charged for your group when reserving an Overnight Permit for entries from May 1 to September 30 each year. When making advanced reservations, you will be given the option to pay for the entire group or charged a minimum of \$32.00 for 2 adults. Remaining balance is collected upon arrival of picking up the permit.

Interagency Senior / Access Pass	\$8
Interagency Youth Access Pass	\$4

Seasonal Fee Card: may be purchased in person after May 1 from any Superior National Forest District Office. This card fulfills the fee requirements for the season but does not eliminate the need for obtaining a BWCAW permit and paying the \$6 non-refundable reservation fee.

Child / Youth	\$32
Interagency Senior / Access Pass	\$32
Interagency Youth Access Pass	\$16

Please note that the discounted prices for the seasonal fee cards are only applied at the time of issuing the permit. Pass holders must present their pass, along with their photo ID, at the time of permit pickup.

Cancellation Policy: If a reservation is cancelled outside the 2-day window prior to your entry date, the user fees paid by the cardholder will be fully refunded. If cancelled within the 2-day window, \$32.00 for 2 adults is retained and additional payments will be refunded. The Forest Service will retain the entire payment if the group is a no show. Adjustments to group sizes can be made at the permit issuing station as needed or you can adjust your group size online. Cancellations and changes to the reservation can be made via www.recreation.gov or by calling (877) 444-6777. A new confirmation letter will be generated each time a change is made.
