

Tuolumne River Wild and Scenic River, CA

Application Process: Permits are available for reservations beginning January 1 through midnight the day prior to the trip at www.recreation.gov/permits/621750. Permits are required anywhere below Holm and Kirkwood Powerhouses to the high-water mark of Don Pedro reservoir between May 1st and October 15th each year. The permit authorizes a single day trip on the Cherry Creek section or a single or multi-day (up to 3 days) trip on the Main Tuolumne section. Trips may be combined to float both sections for a four-day trip. One permit per section is required.

Fees: There is a \$6.00 non-refundable reservation fee. The Recreation Fee is \$2.00 per person, and is refundable when the cancellation takes place 7 days or more before the launch date.

Changes and Cancellations: Changes to the permit may be made 7 days or more before the launch date. Changes include adding or reducing the number of people subject to space availability. To change the start date you must cancel and book a new permit; all fees apply. "No shows" may forfeit any other reservations they might have for the remainder of the season.

Additional information: Water Flows are minimized on every other Wednesday, for flow schedules call 209-929-7825. Flow information is also available at www.dreamflows.com. Road closures can happen due to fires and a heavy rain or snow season, go to <http://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/stanislaus/alerts-notices> check on current alerts.
